YEAR END BANQUET: September 22nd. Location TBA. To qualify for Year End Division awards, riders must compete in the same division for a minimum of four shows for points to count. Points do not carry over from one division to another.

ALL CLASSES COUNT FOR USHJA OUTREACH EXCEPT *

Outreach riders must be a member of USHJA at the FREE Outreach level (or higher) to earn points toward awards and rewards. Horses do not need to be recorded or microchipped to participate. However, those wishing for their horses to earn points toward award must record them with USHJA (\$20/annual or \$75/lifetime).

Class Rules and Guidelines

Blue/Red Schooling Hunters: Open to anyone as a schooling class. Will be given a blue or red as a score. No ribbons will be awarded in this class. It can be ridden as many times as needed, but will be charged for the number of trips ridden. Will be ridden as your 2nd hunter trip. (cross rails—3) *DOES NOT COUNT FOR OUTREACH POINTS

Beginner Division: Open to all riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Fences will not exceed 18". Simple changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross enter only into Tally Ho.

Baby Green Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences of 2' in height. Fence will not exceed 2'.

Novice Division: Open to all juniors and adult amateur riders who have not won more than 6 blue ribbons at fences 2' or above. Fences will not exceed 2'. May only cross enter into Tally Ho. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Rusty Spur Division: Open to all "older" adults (over 25 years old) who are reentering into the show ring or entering into the ring as a "beginner rider". Open to walk/ trot or walk/trot/canter.

Low Hunter: Open to all horses/ponies and riders. Fences are 2'3"

Children's Pony: Open to all juniors and ponies. Small/ mediums jump 2' and larges jump 2'6. Once heights are adjusted, fences will not be readjusted.

Pre-Child/Pre-Adult Hunter: Open to all juniors and adult amateurs. Fences will not exceed 2'6".

Modified Hunters: Open to all riders. Fences will not exceed 2'9".

Child/Adult Hunter: Open to all juniors and adult amateurs. Fences not to exceed 3'.

Tally Ho: Open to all riders and all horses. Will be shown at the walk, trot and canter. May enter in one height A, B, or C. Must be shown during that height section. May cross enter into any other Ring A division.

Maiden Walk / Trot: Open to juniors and adult amateur riders who are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Flat classes will be split only if entries exceed 8 riders. May not cross enter into any other division.

Walk/Trot Crossrails: Open to beginner riders of any age on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter. To be shown at the walk and trot. Flat classes will be split only if entries exceed 8.

Short Stirrup Crossrails: Open to riders of any age on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter. Shown at the walk/trot/canter. Simple changes allowed.

Leadline: Free to children who have not shown and will not show in any other class at this show.

Open Equitation Challenge Flat Class: Open to all riders competing in **Ring A**. At the judge's discretion riders may be asked to ride a pattern or ride without stirrups.

Rusty Spur Award: This award is given to the rider that the judge feels demonstrates what riding as an adult is all about. Going out and having a great time.

Rider raffle: At each show, every rider is given a raffle ticket for each division entry. A blue/red entry does not qualify, nor does leadline. Raffle will be drawn at the year-end banquet. Rider does not need to be present to win.
